Our Mission

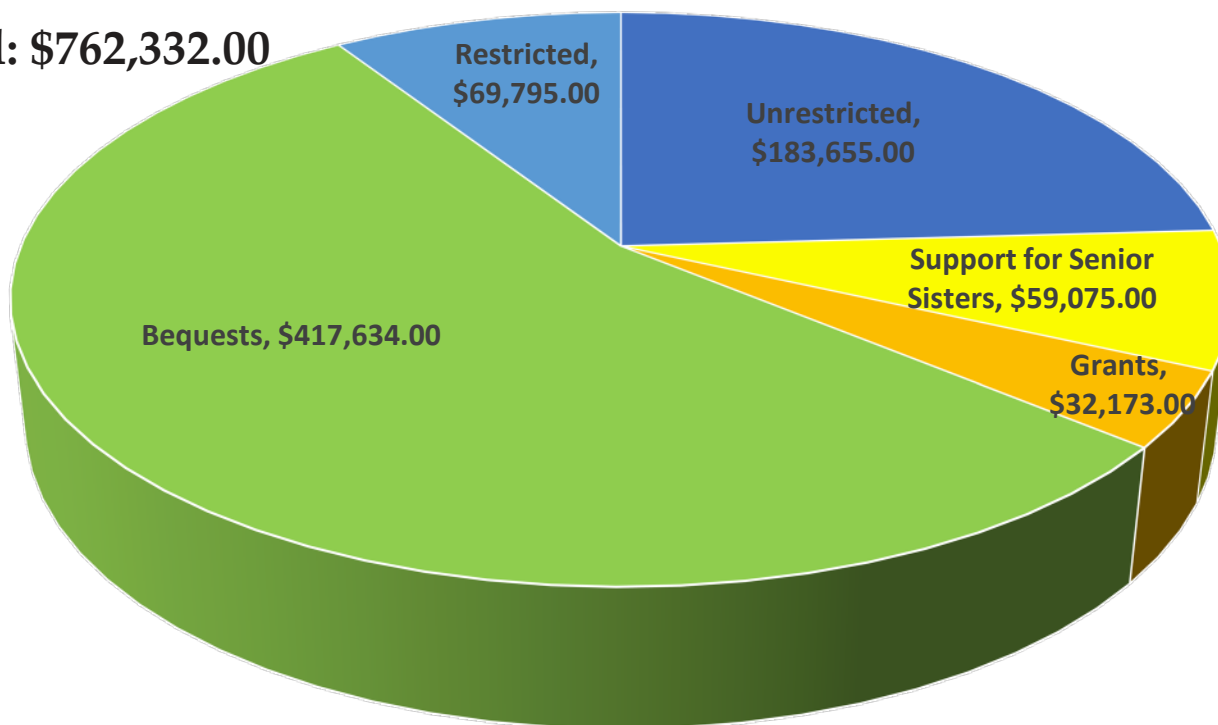

BEQUESTS

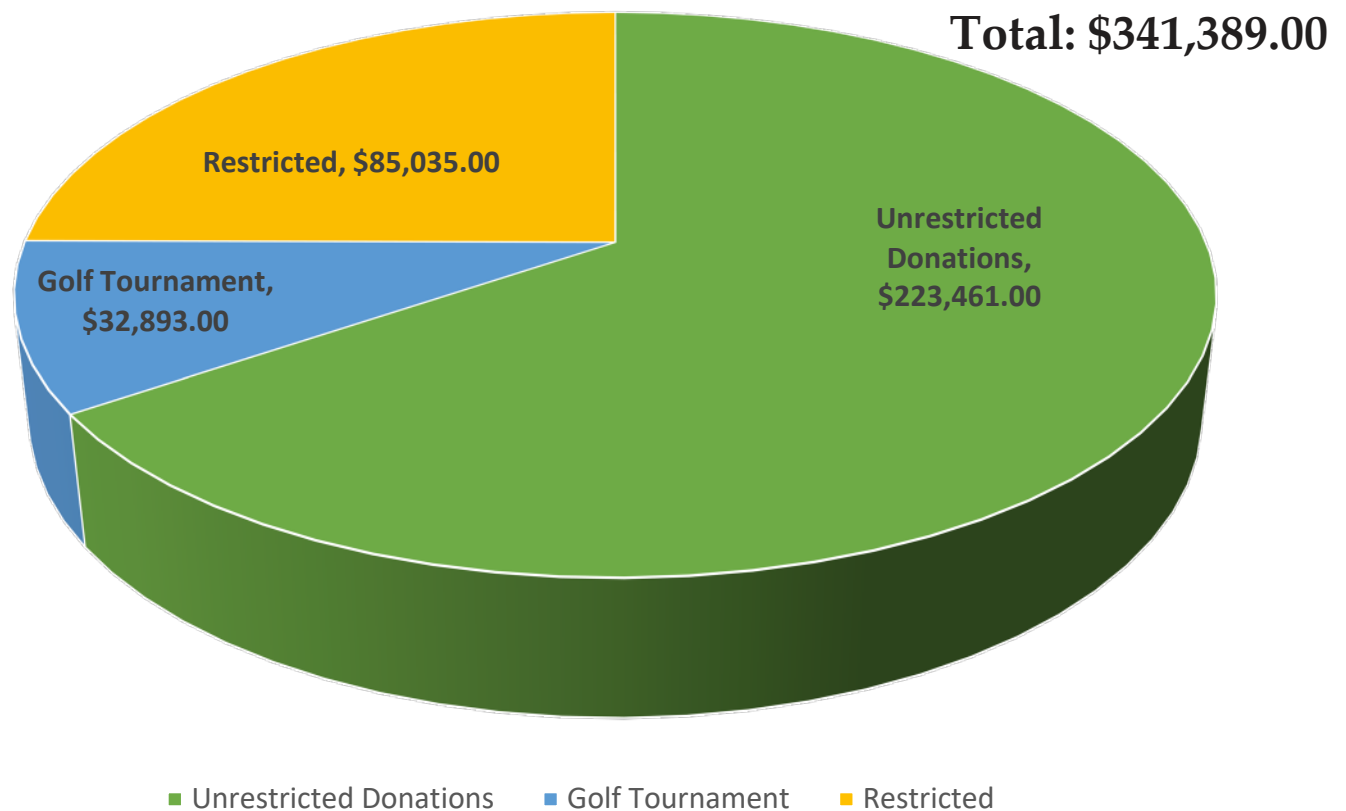
SUPPORT FOR SENIOR SISTERS

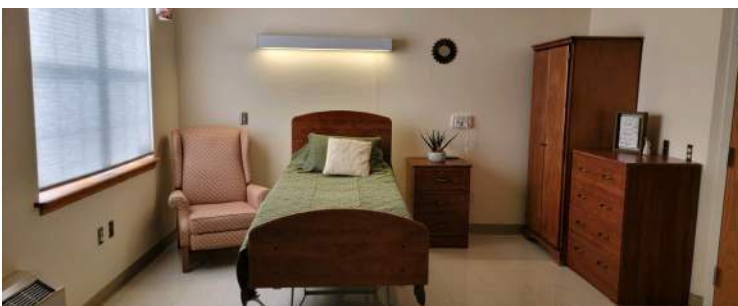
